

List of Words Omitted from Modern Bibles

The New Testaments of all modern bible versions, including the *New King James Version*, are based on the Greek text called *Nestles-United Bible Societies Text (NU)*, which is the result of a modern school of 'textual criticism', which began to be popularised by The Revision Committee of 1881.

The Revision Committee was dominated by two men, Westcott & Hort, and the change in the Greek Text is largely due to their favouring of two manuscripts, *Vaticanus* and *Sinaiticus*. This change involved may thousands of alterations from what was called the *Received Text (TR)*, which the *King James/Authorised Version* and its forerunners were based on.

The result is that the doctrine of the Trinity, the deity of Christ, and other important doctrines are weakened in the new versions, and the new versions distinctly favour Roman Catholic doctrine in a number of places.

Following is a list of such departures from the *Received Text*, and hence, words missing from modern versions (in some cases, where only a word or two is missing, I have underlined the missing words, and included surrounding words for easier understanding). Serious Old Testament changes are listed also.

We must remember that the NU-Text is ever-changing as more discoveries are made by the textual critics, and versions such as the NIV are also being continually updated and changed, therefore an observation made about comparison between the KJV and modern versions may not remain the same as time goes on.

I believe I have personally checked all of the above information, by comparing the relevant KJV readings with the NKJV readings and footnotes – **this is the easiest way to check as the NKJV invariably adds a footnote stating what is omitted or different in the NU-Text.**

There are many more serious discrepancies I could have listed if I had compared the NIV with the KJV, but my main purpose is to show the errors which are consistent in all modern versions because of the changes in the underlying texts, hence all my comparisons are with the NKJV, which is the most accurate of the modern versions, yet an exercise such as this shows just how terribly even it leads its readers astray. It is important to know that the NKJV agrees with other modern versions (in respect of these many omissions from the Received Text) by virtue of its footnotes – typically “*NU-Text omits*”, hence the NKJV is the most deceptive of all.

I want to make some acknowledgements: The list of omissions from the Received Text was originally obtained from “New Eyeopener Tract” by J J Ray. It was so many years ago now that I’d forgotten where I first found that information – it was only by digging through old books and tracts that I rediscovered the fact just now, so I want to acknowledge what a great work this Eyeopener Tract is! Other information I have gleaned over the years has come from “New Age Bible Versions” by Gail Riplinger, “Serious Omissions in the NIV” by Keith Piper, and various Articles by the Trinitarian Bible Society.

Lastly, I also wish to acknowledge that I might never have known about these important matters, had it not been for the gracious gift of Riplinger’s book, by a Mr T Bentley, Trewella Bentley Publications.

When I was a young pastor, less than two years in full time ministry, Mr Bentley, whom I have never met to this day and didn’t know anything of at the time, sent me the book in the mail, and as I began to do my own research, he was also helpful via further written correspondence in pointing me to other publications such as TBS Article concerning questions I could not answer at the time. I had been using the KJV from the beginning of my ministry and for some years before, and had found by experience that it was far superior to modern versions, but had not learned of the extent of the differences, or the reasons, until Mr Bentley’s gracious communication and gift. God is truly gracious to lead His children into all Truth!

I hasten to add that I do not agree doctrinally with everything of Gail Riplinger or Keith Piper, but I acknowledge their works for the good that is in them, and this is the case with all books and ministries, we must be discerning, but at the same time humble enough to learn from others, even if we don't agree with them on every point. Some of the greatest men of the Christian era have been men with whom we would disagree on some points, even on some important doctrines, but we would be foolish to reject such good and great men and their works altogether, because we differ in some degree. By the grace of God we are what we are, and none of us has any reason to boast. But there is a vast difference between good men who are imperfect and men who are dangerous false teachers – I consider those who promote the new, pro-Roman Catholic bible versions while refusing to hear correction, to be dangerous false teachers. That is one important reason for this leaflet – the pastors are generally not warning the flock of God of these awful deceptions! May God be merciful to all His people, and liberate them from the false teachers through His eternal Word! Amen.
